Hedges: laying and planting

I took part last October (I'm sure it was October, how time passes...) in a hedge laying course run by Really Rural and organised by the Stepping Stones project and the CPRE (the Countryside Charity). Why, I hear you ask? Well, I thought it might be a useful skill living in a property surrounded by hedges, having a concern for wildlife and what could be done to protect it and (if I'm honest) that it might be an opportunity to make new friends. It was. I spent two days covered in mud, scratched and struggling with blackthorn, feeling pathetic when, with my full force behind it, my axe just bounced off the wood (yet again!) without seeming to leave a dent. And yet ... I came away feeling as if I had made new friends, was on the journey of learning a new skill and that, as a group, we'd done something useful. We had and I had. Love the friends I made and am waiting, impatiently, for the chance to try out my (very basic) new skills when Autumn comes round again. Thank you, Stepping Stones and CPRE, for giving me an opportunity that I never even realised I wanted! Hedge planting – another story. Even more physically demanding and satisfying. Try it! CPRE is now actively seeking countryside sites (not gardens) for hedgerow creation and for hedge laying training. #### 'On Whinberry Hill'

By the time you read this, we will have held our Whinberry Pick-nic on the Parish Land on the Black Hill and hopefully the Parish Council will have decided to seek a grant from 'Farming in Protected Landscapes', a Defra funded scheme. If an application is made and is successful, it will enable us to do more control of bracken and sitka spruce and to promote recolonisation by heather and bilberry. More news will follow next month.

#### **The Kempton Avenue**

Nearly all of the Turkey Oaks have now been mapped and our next task is to see whether there is a record in the Powis Estate Records held at Shropshire Archives which may tell us more about how many were originally planted and when.

### **Water Monitoring**

This continues on the Clun at Clunton and Clunbury, on the Gunridge Stream and on the Kemp at Kempton. Thanks to grants from the Environment Agency, the AONB and the Kemp Valley Group, we have been able to upgrade elements of our equipment and this will improve the accuracy of our records.
